The State of The Netherlands, the Ministry of Health, Welfare and Sport states hereby that:

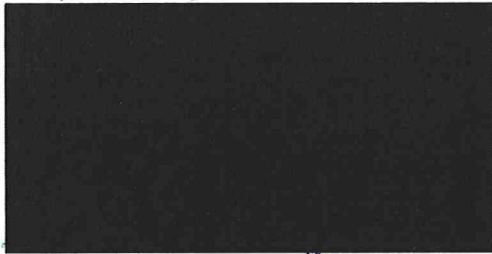
1. The coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak has a big impact on the Netherlands and therefore a wide range of relevant organisations are working together;
2. Mediq is, in partnership with the State of the Netherlands, specifically the Dutch Ministry of Health, Welfare and Sport, working on supporting the Netherlands during the COVID-19 crisis;

During the period as mentioned in paragraph 4 Mediq and **Relief Goods Alliance BV (RGA)** are undertaking all reasonable efforts to continuously supply the Netherlands with high quality medical products sourcing and by securing volumes for weekly cycles for a minimum of 12 weeks, executed in compliance with all relevant rules and regulations;
